FUNCTIONS

- Work all OUA and CIS games (exhibition, regular season, playoffs and championships) as scheduled.
- Perform pre-game/post-game tasks as assigned
- Attend mandatory training and development sessions
- Responsible for uploading graphics, videos and music as required for each sport/game
- Review game script with AV Director and Manager on Duty, coordinate elements as directed throughout the game presentation
- Creation of game specific graphics as needed (video)
- Updating music files, audio clips, as needed (music)
- Ensure proper pronunciation of athlete names, goals, penalties and game updates as required (PA)
