SUMMARY: The game film operator is responsible for recording play for all TMU Basketball, Hockey and Volleyball games. The employee usually works a minimum of 10 hours a week, primarily between Thursday and Sunday.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be able to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Must have a strong skillset in camera equipment and computers.
- Knowledge of basketball (FIBA), hockey (CHA) and volleyball (Volleyball Canada) are required.
- Must be able to work in a team environment.
- Must be able to work Wednesday to Sunday, reading weeks and December break.
- Must be punctual, organized and have the ability to multitask.
- Able to comfortably lift up to 15 lbs.

### JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Work OUA and USports games (exhibition, regular season, playoffs as scheduled).
- Setup and record TMU varsity games.
- Once the game is complete upload the game film to its corresponding cloud service.
- The Gameday dress code is black pants. Polo will be provided. Jeans, shorts, caps/hats and open-toe shoes are not permitted
- Arrive at event venue before scheduled work time to give enough time to store belongings and prepare work station.
- Attend paid training and development sessions.
