Game day dress code is black pants and staff shirt. Jeans, shorts, caps/hats and open toe shoes are not permitted The employee usually works minimum of 10 hours a week, primarily between Wednesday and Sunday.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge of basketball (FIBA), hockey (Hockey Canada) and volleyball (FIVA) is required
- Previous speaking/announcing experience prefered.
- Must be able to work in a fast paced environment.
- Bilingual (English/French) is an asset.
- Must be able to work Wednesday to Sunday, Evenings, Reading Week and December break.
- Ontario Career Boost approval is preferred.
- Must be able to work in a team environment.
- Must be punctual, organized and have the ability to multitask.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Work in teams to setup and teardown game day venues.
- Attend paid training and development sessions.
- Arrive at event venue before scheduled work time to give enough time to store belongings and prepare work station.
- Perform pre-game tasks (i.e. setup workstation).
- Announce game play actions (e.g. points/goals, substitutions, fouls/penalties) and reads during intermissions, halftime and time outs.
